R&R #19.0 HONORARY MEMBERSHIP EFFECTIVE 04-08-87

19.0 HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

1. 19.1 Purpose
To formally recognize those members or persons who either by their services, acts, or deeds have brought benefit to Truro Fire Rescue.
2. 19.2 Eligibility
Any person that has been a member of Truro Fire Rescue and/or by their acts or deeds have benefited the Truro Fire Department.
 - a. Active members of the Department are not eligible for honorary membership.
3. 19.3 Application
Request for honorary membership must be by written request to the Truro Board of Fire Engineers. By,
 - a. The person so requesting honorary membership, or
 - b. recommendation by a Fire department members, or
 - c. recommendation by the Truro board of Fire Engineers.
4. 19.4 Board of Review:
If so requested by the person or persons requesting or recommending an honorary membership, a Board of review may be formed by the Truro Board of Fire Engineers. Said board of Review to consist of a majority of the Fire Department officers and a majority of the Board of Fire Engineers.
 - a. The decision of the board of Fire Engineers will be final.
5. 19.5 Acceptance:
Honorary membership in Truro Fire Rescue will be decided by the Truro Board of Fire Engineers. Confirmation of acceptance will be by written letter and/or an official format signed by the majority of the Board of Fire Engineers.
6. 19.6 Definition of Membership:
 - a. Welcome to attend Department social and/or civic functions as guests of the Department.
 - b. Welcome to attend those Fire department educational training classes or sessions which pertain to an honorary=s member=s desire to retain certification
in the areas of CPR, First Aid, EMT, etc. Participation is limited to classroom training. Prior permission of the Chief Engineer and the instructor presenting said training is required and expenses, if any, shall be the responsibility of honorary member.
 - c. Eligible to receive any badges, certifications, memberships, cards, etc. indicative of honorary membership.

d. Excluded from:

- 1.** Any rights to actively participate in Department drills, calls or other activities that require active membership in Truro Fire Rescue other than aforementioned activities per items Aa@ and Ab@.
- 2.** Any right of vote pertaining to Fire Department business.
- 3.** Attendance at any meetings at which actual rescue squad calls are discussed and/or critiqued.
